Mr. DiPaolo said that he included this discussion of DEI training for the Board because Director Houston indicated at the last Board meeting that this is something the Board should pursue. Chair Agnolucci thanked Mr. DiPaolo for putting it on the agenda, noting that she thinks it is a good idea. She also said that she wants to be mindful of the expense, and wondered whether Director Houston might do research to help find an appropriate consultant or trainer. She said that academia is a special environment with particular issues and she wants training oriented towards that context. Director Robertson added that it might be helpful to connect with UCOP to see what resources it has available for the Regents. He added that there is someone at each of UCLA and UC Berkeley who might be suitable. Dean Kwon said that the College brings in diversity trainers from UCSF. Mr. DiPaolo will reach out to Director Houston to discuss these and any other ideas he has about the training. The College administration will also look into the DEI trainers it has engaged in the past. Mr. DiPaolo will include this as a discussion item on the October Executive Committee meeting agenda for further discussion.
